

## **Troop Youth Leadership Positions**

## **Senior Patrol Leader**

The Senior Patrol leader is the top youth leader in the troop. He or she presides over all meetings and activities, chairs patrol leaders' council meetings, and leads the troop's annual program planning conference. He or she appoints other youth leaders with the advice and consent of the Scoutmaster and oversees their training and work.

## **Assistant Senior Patrol Leader**

The assistant senior patrol leader trains and gives direct leadership to appointed youth leaders such as the scribe and quartermaster. He or she helps the senior patrol leader run meetings and activities and guides the troop in the senior patrol leader's absence.

## **Patrol Leader**

The patrol leader plans and leads patrol meetings and activities. He or she represents his patrol at all patrol leaders' council meetings and at the annual program planning conference. He knows the needs and capabilities of his patrol members and works to make them successful.
